Hands On/Verbal: El Restaurante

A. When the team enters the room, tell them, "This is a Hands-On Verbal problem. In an actual tournament you will have one minute to select five team members to compete. The others can leave or stay to watch, sitting in seats away from the table. If they stay in the room, they cannot assist in solving the problem and cannot talk at ANY time. However, today all team members can participate.

B. JUDGE READS TO TEAM:

- 1. In this problem, you will have 6 minutes to develop your solution. You will then have one minute to present your solution. You may talk and ask questions during this practice time, however, time will continue.
- 2. Your problem is to create items using the materials on the table. You are in charge of creating a new zany restaurant for other fellow OMers, and you need to create items that will help to advertise your restaurant. You must also create a jingle to help advertise your restaurant, which will be presented in your one minute presentation. Examples of this jingle could include the Oscar Meyer theme song, or the McDonald's theme song.
- 3. Scoring will be as follows:
 - 1-10 points for the originality of the restaurant and its theme.
 - 1-15 points for the originality and presentation of the jingle.
 - 1-20 points for teamwork.
- 4. Once again, your problem is to create and present an original restaurant and jingle using the materials on the table. Your restaurant should have a theme, and the jingle must be original and help to advertise your restaurant. You will have 6 minutes to create and develop your presentation, and one minute to present your solution.
